Online Course on Transplant Coordination Professional Certificate

A short-term online course on 'Transplant Coordination Professional Certificate' was successfully conducted by MOHAN Foundation. Two batches were trained during the period from March 2023 to June 2023. The course was designed with online modules and interactive webinars to create an engaging and informative learning environment for the participants.

The webinars focused on

- Basic concepts of organ donation and transplantation
- Transplantation of Human Organ Act, Rules and Amendments
- Role of a donor coordinator in deceased organ donation and documentation
- Approaching families for organ donation and case studies
- Living donor transplant coordination – Role of a transplant coordinator
- Role of a transplant coordinator in recipient coordination (Heart and Lung Program)
- Ethical considerations in organ donation

16	Certificate of registration for organ/tissue transplantation/retrieval and/or tissue banking	Issued on the letterhead
17	Certificate of renewal of registration	Issued on the letterhead
18	Certificate by the authorization committee of hospital	Issued on the letterhead
19	Certificate by competent authority for Indian near relative other than spouse	Issued on the letterhead
20	Verification certificate in respect of domicile status of recipient or donor	Tehsildar/authorized officer (required only for donor - other than near relative or recipient if they do not belong to state where transplant hospital is located)
21	Certificate of relationship between donor and recipient in case of foreigners	Embassy concerned
